Questions on State Candidate Surveys:

1. Do you support Indiana law that a woman must be given opportunity to see an ultrasound of the baby, and to hear the baby's heartbeat, at least 18 hours before an abortion?
2. Do you support Indiana law prohibiting abortion based solely on a baby's race, sex, potential disability, or Down syndrome?
3. Do you support Indiana law providing for licensing and criminal penalties for doctors who do illegal abortions, and for pharmacists who illegally dispense abortion drugs?
4. Would you support holding county prosecutors accountable for a blanket refusal to enforce whole sections of Indiana Code, including Indiana's abortion law?
5. Do you support Indiana law prohibiting physician-assisted suicide and euthanasia?
6. Do you support Indiana law prohibiting the cloning of human embryos?
7. Would you support requiring humane medical care for babies born alive as a result of an attempted abortion, regardless of the baby's stage of development?
8. Do you oppose using taxpayer funds to pay for elective abortions, to subsidize abortion providers, or to subsidize abortion referring agencies, such as Planned Parenthood?
9. Do you support Indiana law stating that human physical life begins when a human ovum is fertilized by human sperm?
10. Do you support Indiana law protecting women from being coerced into an abortion?
11. Do you support Indiana law requiring that aborted babies be buried or cremated?
12. Do you support Indiana law prohibiting telemedicine for abortion, including the writing or filling of a prescription intended to cause an abortion?
13. Do you support Indiana's tax credit of \$2,500 per adopted child?
14. Will you support continued funding for Indiana's Real Alternatives program that helps pro-life pregnancy resource centers meet the needs of pregnant mothers and their unborn babies?

5. Would you vote against any federal legislation that would place new limits on the ability of states to regulate abortion?
6. Would you oppose any legislation that would weaken the Hyde Amendment and other current laws that restrict federal subsidies for abortion?
7. Would you vote to prevent U.S. funding of the United Nations Population Fund?
8. Would you vote for the Child Interstate Abortion Notification Act?
9. Would you vote for the No Taxpayer Funding for Abortion Act?
